7.2. Contest area is the territory of Germany, Poland and Czech Republic.

7.3 Out of bounds are all islands in the North or Baltic Sea without natural connection to the mainland.

7.4 PZ1: Airspace Class C and D around Berlin

8.6.i: Official time is GPS time, there will be no time check during briefings.

9.4 u. 9.6: We do not use a flag pole. Messages will be given by officials verbally to each team.

9.5 Coordinates of common Launch point: 51°37,481'N 12°17,677'E (Launchpad No 7)

10.6 Observers are not considered as passengers, they may fly unless otherwise stated in the task sheet.

10.9 The use of water ballast is mandatory over buildings and cars around the launch field.

10.12 Landing reports by SMS are welcome.

12.1 Valid goals are intersections between roads of type "primary road, secondary road" on the German maps and "Main road, road" on the Jeppesen maps.

12.2: For Coordinates in Degrees, Minutes and one Decimal, for example: 51° 39,7'N 07° 10,1'O. Observers please use full accuracy of the GPS.

Please set all GPS accordingly and use WGS 84. Christian Michel can help you.

12.3 "congested areas" are all irregular shaped yellow built-up areas in the maps. The small circular ones are not "congested" in the sense of 12.3.

12.7 An observer flying in the balloon may give the permission to the ground crew via radio to paint and collect the marker.

14.1 Official Notice board is in the entrance of the hotel.
